English

<u>Maths</u>

Within the third term, we will be continuing to look at multiplication and division using formal methods. Then we will be moving on to length and perimeter.

Reading

Curriculum

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In history, we will be learning about the Egyptians. We will cover mummification, the pyramids and pharaohs. In geography, we will be learning about Europe; different countries and cultures and the rivers that run throughout Europe. In science we will learn about animals including humans. We will develop your understanding of food chains, herbivores, omnivores and carnivores and the digestive system, including teeth.
