# <u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term, we will be extending our learning of place value to numbers within 50, before moving on to measurement.

#### **English**

## Other subjects

**History:** We will be concluding our learning about the plague before beginning an exciting new topic, the Great Fire of London.

### <u>P.E</u>
