# Year 3 Term 5 Newsletter



#### Welcome back to Term 4!

We hope you had a lovely Easter break Below is a summary of what you will be learning this term...

#### English

In English, we will be studying Escape to Pompeii by Christina Balet. It is closely linked to previously studied history and geography topics as it includes both Roman life and volcanic eruptions. We will be looking at different genres/styles of writing and applying key features to our own writing. We will continue to look at different areas of SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) each week and ensure these are always applied in our writing.



#### <u>Maths</u>

Within the fifth term, we will be continuing with fractions and starting to find fractions of a set of objects. We will also be learning about money – adding, subtracting and converting it between pounds and pence. Finally, we will start to look at telling the time and accurately reading both analogue and digital clocks.

#### <u>Reading</u>

You will take 2 reading books home - one is matched to your reading level and the other is a reading for pleasure book of your choice. You will be expected to read every day with a comment in your contact book signed by an adult at home. Adults in school will also be checking the contact books daily for any messages from parents.

In school, we will have guided reading sessions in class which will be based around VIPERS. In addition to this, you will have reading for pleasure time.

#### <u>Curriculum</u>

In history, we will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons. Specifically, about the invasion of Britain and their beliefs and burials. In geography, we will be learning about international trade and the

formation of earthquakes and volcanoes. In science we will be looking at how animals and plants inherit characteristics from their parents and how animals adapt to their habitats to survive. We will also be learning about fossils and the process of fossilisation. Later in the term we will look forces and specially magnetism.

### <u>PE</u>

This term we will have **outdoor PE** on **Tuesday afternoon** and **indoor PE** on a **Thursday morning**. Please ensure you wear your PE kit to school on these days. Earrings should not be worn during PE lessons, so it is advised to keep them at home.
