## It's good to talk

During the school day, children have many opportunities to talk to adults if and when they need to. When talking may not be possible, we have two in-class initiatives that are followed across the school: 'Bubble Time' and 'Think Boxes'. For Bubble Time, your child can move their peg onto the 'talk bubble' to indicate that they would like to speak with an adult regarding an incident or problem. Similarly, the Think Box is for children to share their thoughts or ask a question by writing it down and posting it into the box. All children should be aware that any adult that is seen with a rainbow lanyard is a safe and approachable adult, equipped to deal with any concerns they have.

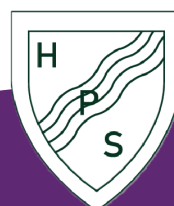

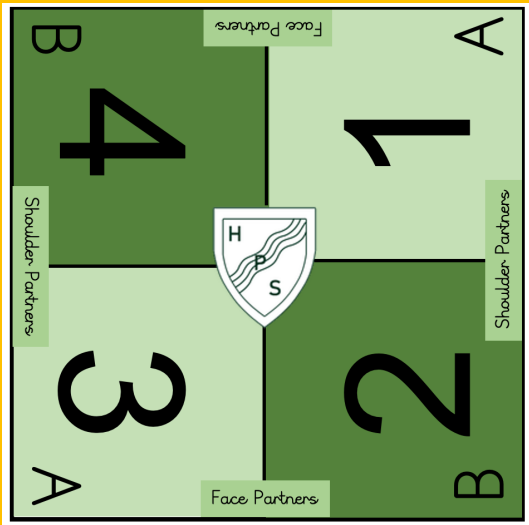

Our improvement priorities in Halling’s 180 Day Plan for Terms 1-3 are as follows:

- 2023-2024 Priorities:**
1. Improving Outcomes, including Greater Depth and Narrowing the Disadvantaged Gap
  2. Embedding and Developing AAT Core Curriculum Principles and ‘Pedagogy’ Principles
  3. Developing and Strengthening Leadership at all Levels, including Governance
  4. Early Years: Strengthening Provision and Outcomes
  5. Strengthening the Curriculum across the School, including Wider Opportunities

We will continue to develop and embed ‘Kagan Structures’ this academic year. Your child may have come home and talked about: Rally Robin, Round Robin and Think Pair Share! These are just some of the strategies we are now using in our lessons to enable the children to have a more active role in collaboration with their class mates. Research shows that this approach to teaching and learning helps with long term memory retention and, of course, it goes hand in hand with our Chris Quigley curriculum which is also designed around long term memory retention. You could ask your child if they have used the Kagan Mat below - can they explain it to you?
