It's Good to Be Me!

Communication and Language This term we will be learning to:

Follow simple instructions.

Share some news with a group.

Join in with nursey rhymes and stories.

Please help me by:

Giving me a short instruction to follow. Asking me questions about my day. Singing some nursery rhymes with me.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development This term we will be learning to:

Use the toilets independently, safely, and sensibly.

Become more outgoing with new adults and children in my class.

Play co-operatively in a group.

Please help me by:

Talking to me about school rules. Encourage me to independently use the toilet and clean myself.

Physical Development This term we will be learning to:

Move around the classroom safely and sensibly.

Develop movement and balancing skills. Use large muscle movements to wave ribbons, paint and make marks.

Use a comfortable grip to hold a pen pencil.

Please help me by:

Give me opportunities to mark make. Remind me about moving around safely. Taking me to the park.

Literacy

This term we will be learning to:

Recognise letters and say the correct sounds.

Hear and say initial sounds in words.

Handle books carefully and correctly.

Begin to write my name.

You can help me by:

Reading with or to me every day. Playing games such as" I spy". Helping me to write some or all letters of my name.

Mathematics

This term we will be learning

Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects without counting them individually ('Subitising') Count and recognise numerals up to 5.

Understand positional language "The bag in under the table" without pointing.

Please help me by:

Giving me an instruction "Put your hat in the box"
Singing counting songs.

Understanding the World This term we will be learning to:

Begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.

Talk about and describe what we see.

Please help me by:

Talking to me about my family. Look at photos and encourage me to talk about my memories. Make observations such as "the sponge is soft and wet. The rock is heavy and hard."

Expressive Arts and Design This term we will be learning to:

Take part in pretend play.

Respond to what they have heard, expressing thoughts and feelings. Explore different materials freely, choosing how to use them and what to make.

Please help me by:

Providing opportunities to create by using paints, glue, and Sellotape.

Move our body to the sound of the music-have a dance in your living room!
