Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. As the Chair of the Halling PTA, I wanted to inform you about some important updates regarding our fundraising events for the children at our school.

After discussing with the school office, we have decided that all PTA events for each term will now be listed on Arbor at the beginning of the term. This change is intended to give you ample time to make payments for events such as discos and items on School Shop.

However, please note that once the payment deadline has passed, we will not be able to reopen Arbor for additional payments. This decision is based on safeguarding concerns and the need to manage event numbers accurately.

Allowing children to be added after the deadline, creates serious safeguarding issues. I want to emphasise that the office staff will not be able to reopen the system under any circumstances or take any cash/BACS payments as these are PTA-managed events.

We hope that you will appreciate the extended period available for payments and understand that the safety and security of our children must always be our top priority.




Attendance and Punctuality

In order to reduce the number of children arriving late for school in the morning, we thought it would be another good opportunity to remind you of the following points:

- Pupils must arrive in school by <u>08:50</u> on each school day.
- The register for the first session will be taken from 08:45 and will be kept open until 08:50.
- A pupil who arrives late via the office (after the register has closed at 08:50) but before 09:00, will be marked as late, using the L code.
- A pupil who arrives after 09:00 will be marked as late or absent, using the U code (unauthorised).
