in the classroom

In English, we will be studying the text *Wonder* by R.J. Palacio. We will be learning about different styles of writing and applying this to our own writing with elements of SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar). Try to log onto Spelling Shed to help with learning the Year 5 and 6 spelling words.

Within maths, we will be focusing on place value up to 10,000,000. Then, we will move onto the 4 operations. Try and practise as much as you can at home by using websites such as TTRS.

During term 1, we will learn about the Aztecs in history and North America in geography. In science, we will start learning about living things before moving onto investigating materials. You should have learnt these topics at a basic level in Year 5 and study them deeper in Year 6.

We also have exciting lessons in art, DT, computing, MFL, music, PSHE and RE.
