in the classroom

In English, we will be studying the text *The Light Jar* by Lisa Thompson. We will be learning about different styles of writing and applying this to our own writing with elements of SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar). Try to log onto Spelling Shed to help with learning the Year 5 and 6 spelling words as we will try and include them in our writing regularly.

Within maths, we will be focusing on fractions. We will learn how to apply the 4 operations to fractions. We will continue to revisit previous learning to consolidate what we have learnt. Try and practise as much as you can at home by using websites such as TTRS as this is the foundation to many mathematical concepts.

During term 2, we will learn about the Ancient Greeks in history and continue to investigate North America in geography. In science, we will start to investigate electricity. Some of these topics would have been learnt at a basic level in Year 5 and we will study them deeper in Year 6. We also have exciting lessons in art, DT, computing, MFL, music, PSHE and RE.

Outdoor PE will be on **Monday afternoons** and **indoor PE** will be on a **Thursday afternoon**. Children need to come into school wearing their PE kits.
