## Upcoming Learning

### English

In English, we will be studying 'Velveteen Rabbit' by Margery Williams. We will be looking at different genres/styles of writing such as diaries, letters, narrative and applying key features to our own writing. We will continue to look at different areas of SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) each week and ensure these are always applied in our writing.

### Maths

We will be starting to look at fractions and understanding the key vocabulary of numerator, denominator and equal parts. We will then look at mass and capacity in the final weeks.

### Curriculum

In History, we will be continuing our learning about the Romans. We will cover how the Romans expanded, why they invaded Britain and what life was like in Roman Britain. In geography, we will be learning about the major mountain ranges and rivers in Europe. In science we will be looking at physics and light. We have many other exciting lessons planned in our other subjects too!
